ENTRANCE HALL Blue painted wooden front door with storm porch opening into a small entrance hall with space for coats and shoes.

Further oak door leading into the sitting room.

Wooden flooring and white walls.

SITTING ROOM 11' 9" \times 11' 9" (3.6m \times 3.6m) Cosy front reception room with double glazed window to the front and wood-burning stove.

Attractive wooden flooring and white decor.

Fitted storage areas in the fireplace alcove and a useful desk niche in the under-stairs

KITCHEN 11' 9" x 6' 6" (3.6m x 2m) Pretty country-style kitchen with a range of white shaker style bottom cupboards and rustic white-wood wall units.

Solid oak worktop and white ceramic sink.

Double glazed window and door opening to the rear courtyard.

Dark grey floor tiles and white decor / wall tiles.
Appliance spaces for oven, washing machine and under counter fridge.

STAIRS AND LANDING Wooden stairs with carpet steps rise to the first floor landing. White decor with attractive naked red brickwork to the far end of the landing. Useful storage space fitted above the stainwell, also housing the electric hot water tank, and at the end with walk-in wardshe (such sort).

Wooden laminate flooring and solid oak doors to all rooms.

BEDROOM ONE 11' 9" \times 9' 10" (3.6m \times 3m) Double bedroom with double glazed window to the front.

Walk-in wardrobe providing plenty of storage space together with fitted cupboards in the fireplace alcove. Wooden laminate flooring and white decor with naked brickwork. Electric heater.

BEDROOM TWO 8' 2" x 6' 10" (2.5m x 2.1m) Small double or good-sized single bedroom with double glazed window to

GARDENS From the courtyard at the immediate rear, steps rise up to the main garden area which is mostly laid to lawn and surrounded by mature shrubs and

Thoughtful planting together with fixed arches and paving make this a beautiful relaxing space, and receiving full sunshine through most of the day.

To the side of the higher level is a large wooden shed with additional pretty nook with water feature on the far side.
