On the ground floor, the main reception room features a period fireplace with inset multi-fuel stove, a large window, and hall access from outside. The beautiful kitchen includes dining space, natural light, built-in pantries and exposed beams, creating a practical and sociable hub of the home.

There are three double bedrooms. The main bedroom includes an en-suite and built-in wardrobes and bedroom furniture including; dressing table, drawers and bedside cabinets. The remaining two double bedrooms both enjoy pleasant views. The main bathroom is fitted with a Jacuzzi bath and heated towel rail

On the lower ground floor there is a hallway with extensive built in storage and external door to the garden. A second reception room with multi-fuel stove also benefiting from direct access to the garden, a utility/study/occasional bedroom with its own shower room and direct access from outside, which may suit an older relative, teenager or anyone seeking more independent space. Externally, the property offers a low maintenance garden, single garage with workup under the garage, and ample driveway parking. A porch provides a

useful entrance area. The location provides access to public transport links, with Keighley railway station offering services to Leeds and Bradford, typically in around 30-40 minutes, and connections across West Yorkshire. Hebden Bridge is also 20 minutes drive and then a 30/35 minutes train to Manchester from there. Local bus routes serve Haworth and surrounding villages. The area is known for nearby parks, established walking and cycling routes, including those associated with the Brontë countryside and moorland. Haworth's village centre provides shops, cafés and everyday amenities, while local schools in and around Haworth and Keighley are accessible by a short drive or bus journey.
